

## **Guideline for shipment of wooden materials to Brazil (packing material; dunnage; lashing materials)**

Due to guidelines released in Brazil and valid as of 1st of February 2016 the following wording has to be listed in each bill of lading for all shipments with final destination Brazilian ports:

The declaration must follow the below format:

- Wooden Packing: Processed Wood;
- Wooden Packing: Treated and certified (the materials have been treated and/or fumigated and include a Certificate);
- Wooden Packing: Not Treated and not Certified (the materials have not been treated nor fumigated and do not include a Certificate);
- Wooden Packing: Not Applicable (when packing material is not wooden).

The exporter has duly to declare towards Conceptum Logistics in written form which wooden packing/dunnage/lashing materials have been used enabling us to insert such information into the bill of lading.

The exporter is fully responsible for the correctness of such information.
